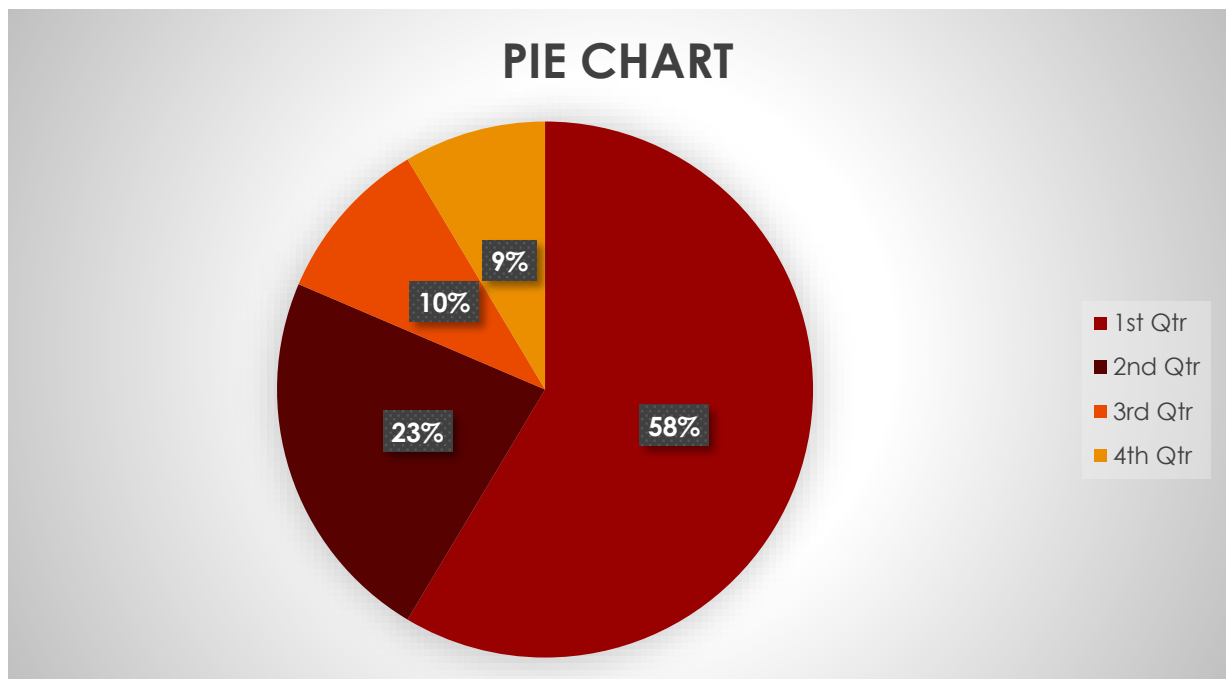


IELTS writing task 1. Vocabulary

There should be no interpretation or analysis, just a factual description.

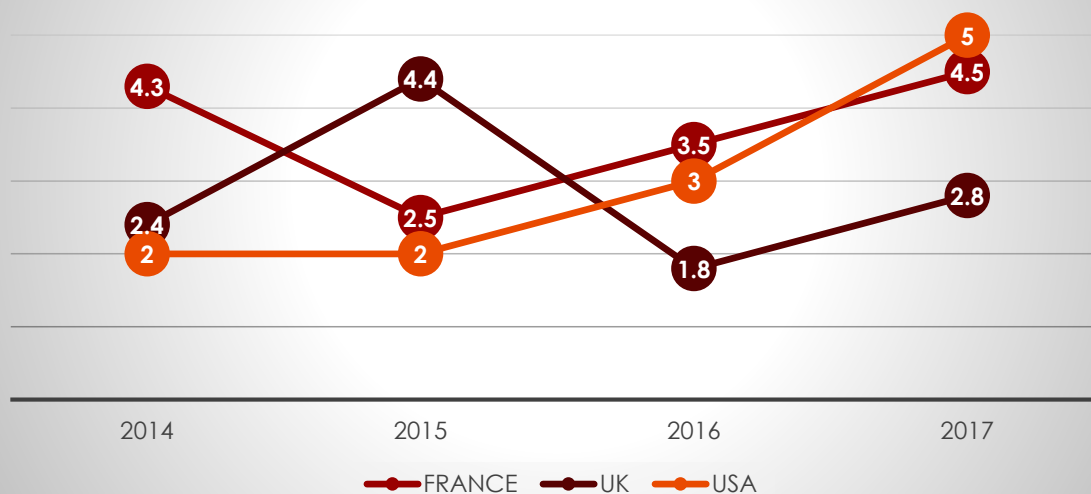
What do you need to describe?

There are several variations of this task: a chart/graph, a table, a map or a process/cycle.

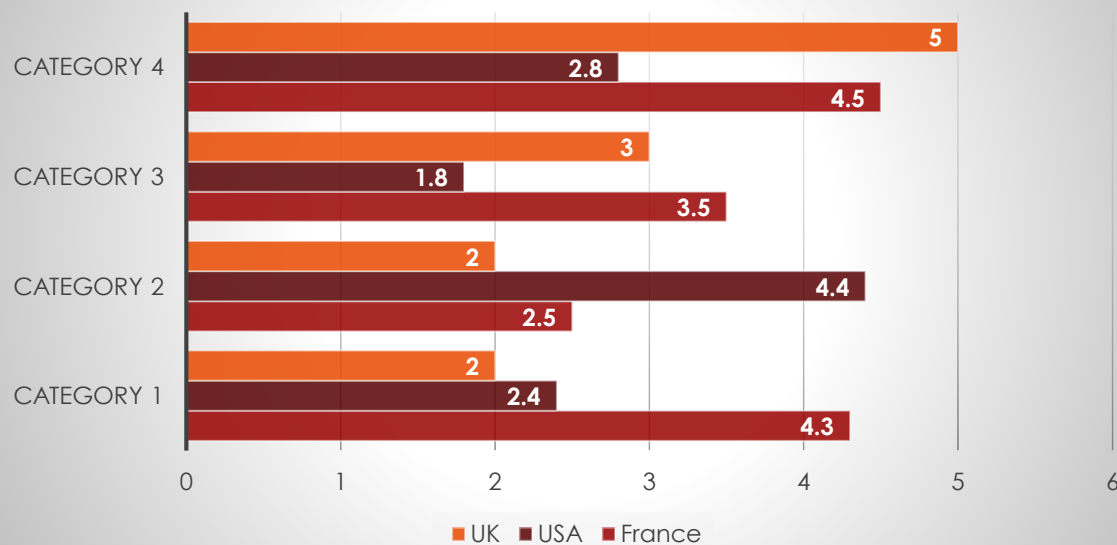




LINE CHART
